Chapel Burial Ground

The first part of the list is taken from the old chapel record book as well as from any remaining gravestones. There are many small discrepancies between gravestones and the records. The record book ends after 1954, thereafter the record relies on gravestones, Ron Moule's memory and research by Mrs King of Kelsall and Roy Silver.

A 'n/r' under 'Minister' indicates that a gravestone exists, but there is no record of it in the record book.
